ICSS 2: 1 Millfield

With another game being played simultaneously against Taunton International the IC split their resources between the two games; giving an U16B side the chance to prove themselves against a good opposition. The match was played on a Saturday afternoon, in perfect conditions for each side to make the most of.

The majority of the first half was played between the two midfields with both sides limited to a couple of chances. The sides were separated at half time by a goal from a Millfield player, a shot from outside the area which the defence was unlucky to concede. Shortly after Javier was then able to celebrate a second goal after racing onto a through ball by Vadim, a chance created from nothing.

The IC played out the game well and could have scored more as Vadim and Javier forced the goalkeeper into a couple of very good saves. The match ended 2-1 to the college; an extremely good performance with every member of the team playing their part from attack to defence.
